Recycling Program

Please use this guide to assist you in properly preparing and disposing of your recyclable materials. We appreciate your cooperation and participation in this program as we do our part to help protect the environment.

PREPARATION OF RECYCLABLES

Please review the following instructions carefully and follow them while preparing recyclable items:

- Recyclables need to be relatively clean, dry, and empty.
- Lightly rinse the recyclable container, if necessary, to remove food particles. Please be conscientious of your water use while rinsing the containers.
- Do not place recyclables in a plastic bag – they should be uncontained when placed in the recycling bin. **Continue to bag and tie your trash placed in the trash receptacle, however, as doing so will help contain odors and reduce pests.**
- Remove non-recyclable material from the recyclable item (such as plastic cereal inserts).
- Plastic and metal caps and labels do not need to be removed from the recyclable item.

RECYCLABLE

PAPER

- Newspaper
- Junk mail with envelopes
- Magazines and catalogs
- Advertising inserts (from mail and newspaper)
- Telephone books
- White or colored paper, including computer paper
- Brown paper bags

PLASTICS

- PET (#1) and HDPE (#2) plastics – look for these symbols at the bottom of the containers:



- Examples include: water bottles, soda bottles, milk jugs, detergent/fabric softener bottles

CANS

- Aluminum (example: beverage cans)
- Steel/tin (examples: soup, vegetable, pet food, tuna cans)
- Aerosol cans (must be empty)
- Foil and foil baking pans

BOXES

- Cardboard without packing materials (examples: corrugated, cereal, cracker, and cake mix boxes)
- Chipboard

NON-RECYCLABLE

To prevent contamination, please do not place the following items in the recycling bin.

- Glass (bottles, vases, light bulbs)
- Plastic bags
- Plastic items that do not display this logo on the bottom:



- Shredded paper
- Carpeting
- Clothing
- Diapers
- Fast food materials (food, straws, wrappers)
- Hangers (metal or plastic)
- Household trash
- Landscaping/yard waste
- Styrofoam (packing peanuts included)
- Tires
- Construction waste
- Appliances
- Vehicle parts
