



Please review the information below to familiarize yourself with the holiday schedule and collection policies. This document provides a quick guide to your services – complete policies are online at parksandsons.com.

SERVICE ESSENTIALS



COLLECTION TIME: Trash and recyclables must be out by 5:30 a.m. on the day of service. You may also choose to set your items out the night before.



PLACEMENT: Trash is collected from the area immediately surrounding your underground container or alley. Do not place anything you want to keep within 10 feet of your trash can so that it not confused as trash.



CONTAINMENT: Trash must be contained in bins (up to 35 gallons), bags, or boxes. No bin, bag, or box may exceed 50 pounds. If you use a box or other container to dispose of trash or recyclables, mark "SAVE" clearly on the side.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

Place your recyclables in the bin(s) of your choice (e.g. cardboard box, basket, plastic bin).

Recyclables must be placed at the end of your driveway on the side opposite of the underground can.

Recycling is not collected on the 5th Wednesdays of the month! See reverse side of this document for more details on the commingled recycling program.

SPECIAL WASTE



CITRUS: Place your citrus in a bag or container above-ground to prevent injury to employees. Each bag or container should weigh less than 50 pounds.



CACTUS: All cacti must be placed in throwaway boxes and sealed shut to prevent any debris from flying. These boxes will not be returned.



COOKING OILS: If you use any type of cooking oil to be disposed of, contact Customer Service to arrange for a separate pick up free of charge.



SYRINGES: Dispose of your needles in a sealed container such as a coffee can or milk jug.



TRIMMINGS: Yard debris and trimmings must be contained and/or tied in bundles (cannot be loose). Trimmings must be less than 4 feet in length and weigh less than 50 pounds. Tree trunks and branches must be less than 8 inches in diameter.



LARGE/BULK ITEM DISPOSAL: If you have an excessive amount of trash or large items to be disposed of, contact Customer Service to arrange for a special pickup and pricing.



UNACCEPTABLE WASTE: Remodeling or construction debris, dirt, rocks, cement, or roofing shingles cannot be taken with the regular collection. If you need to dispose of these types of items, contact Customer Service to make special arrangements (additional charges will apply).



HAZARDOUS WASTE: Materials such as motor oils, tires, car batteries, chemicals, and paint cannot be placed in the regular trash. For proper disposal methods, contact Customer Service or visit parksandsons.com/hazardous.

Service days that fall on or after a recognized holiday will be delayed one day that week. Service days that fall before a recognized holiday are not affected and will remain on schedule. **If a holiday is not mentioned in the schedule, your collection will not be affected.**

COMMINGLED RECYCLING PROGRAM

PAPER



Newspaper, junkmail, envelopes
Magazines, catalogs, paper bags
Telephone books

PLASTICS



Plastic cups, bottles, jugs, cartons
Styrofoam cups, containers
Look for triangle with 1 through 7

GLASS



Food jars
Beverage bottles

CARDBOARD



Cardboard without packing materials
Chipboard
Boxes

ALUMINUM & TIN



Aluminum, steel, tin cans
Aerosol cans (must be empty)
Foil and foil baking pans



Recyclables Preparation

Please use this guide to assist you in properly preparing and disposing of your recyclable items. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact Parks & Sons Customer Service at (623) 974-4791, or visit us online at parksandsons.com.



Recyclables must be relatively clean, dry, and empty. Examples of this include a mayonnaise jar wiped clean of residue with a spatula or emptying a soda bottle in the sink.



Lightly rinse the recyclable container, if necessary, to remove food particles. Recyclables do not need to be run through a dishwasher, but simply cleaned of most residue.



Remove non-recyclable material from the items (such as plastic cereal inserts). Plastic and metal caps and labels do not need to be removed from the recyclables.



Do not place recyclables in plastic bags – they should be uncontained when placed in your recycle container(s). Continue to bag and tie your trash placed in trash receptacles as doing so will help contain odors and reduce pests.



Place recyclables in the bin(s) of your choice (e.g. cardboard box, basket, plastic crate), which will be emptied and left for reuse on recycle days. *If you use a cardboard box and wish to keep it for future use, please mark "SAVE" on the side.*



Recyclables must be out for collection the previous night or no later than 5:30 am the day of service. **Place at the end of your driveway on the side opposite of the underground can.**

Non-Recyclable Items

- Household trash
- Plastic bags
